Genesis 1:1 KJV

I In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

Here's Jesus speaking about when was the beginning...

<u>Matthew 19:4 AMPC</u> 4 He replied, <u>Have you never read</u> that He Who <u>made them from the</u> <u>beginning</u> made them male and female

John 8:31-32 AMPC 31 So Jesus said to those Jews who had believed in Him, <u>If you abide in</u> My word [hold fast to My teachings and live in accordance with them], you are truly My disciples. 32 And you will know the Truth, and the Truth will set you free.

6 But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female.

The "Never Wrong" Prophet Hosea wrote...

Hosea 4:6 AMPC 6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge;

David wrote...

<u>Psalm 119:130 KJV</u>

130 The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.

Psalm 119:130 AMPC

130 The entrance and unfolding of Your words give light; their unfolding gives understanding (discernment and comprehension) to the simple.

The "things" we are studying in this series will not just bring answers to the several questions regarding creation science but... it also enriches our understating of God's Word - "Within the covers of the Bible are the answers for all the problems men face."

In the Psalms, David is attributed to writing much of it's content. While David is not generally numbered among "the Prophets" in the narrow sense of those specific Biblical authors who wrote that category of Old Testament books, David was filled with the Holy Spirit by whom he wrote the Psalms, many of which were prophetically foretelling the coming of the Messiah. As such, David can rightly be called a prophet, as he is in the New Testament.

David is called a Prophet in one of Peter's sermons in the book of Acts:

Acts 2:21-30 AMPC

21 And it shall be that whoever shall call upon the name of the Lord [invoking, adoring, and worshiping the Lord—Christ] shall be saved. 22 You men of Israel, listen to what I have to say: Jesus of Nazareth, a Man accredited and pointed out and shown forth... ...and commended and attested to you by God by the mighty works and [the power of performing] wonders and signs which God worked through Him [right] in your midst, as you yourselves know—

23 This Jesus, when delivered up according to the definite and fixed purpose and settled plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and put out of the way [killing Him] by the hands of lawless and wicked men.

24 [But] God raised Him up, liberating Him from the pangs of death, seeing that it was not possible for Him to continue to be controlled or retained by it.

25 <u>For David says in regard to Him, I saw the Lord constantly before</u> <u>me, for He is at my right hand that I may not be shaken or overthrown</u> <u>or cast down [from my secure and happy state].</u>

26 Therefore my heart rejoiced and my tongue exulted exceedingly; moreover, my flesh also will dwell in hope [will encamp, pitch its tent, and dwell in hope in anticipation of the resurrection].

27 For You will not abandon my soul, leaving it helpless in Hades (the state of departed spirits), nor let Your Holy One know decay or see destruction [of the body after death].

28 You have made known to me the ways of life; You will enrapture me [diffusing my soul with joy] with and in Your presence.

29 Brethren, it is permitted me to tell you confidently and with freedom concerning the <u>patriarch David</u> that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day.

30 **<u>Being however a prophet</u>**, and knowing that God had sealed to him with an oath that He would set one of his descendants on his throne,

Even when they don't use the word, the New Testament writers clearly regarded David as a prophet...

Acts 1:16 AMPC

16 Brethren, he said, it was necessary that the Scripture be fulfilled which the Holy Spirit foretold by the lips of David, about Judas who acted as guide to those who arrested Jesus. The language of "the Holy Spirit foretold by the lips of David" is an obvious reference to prophecy...Jesus Himself said things like:

Matthew 22:42-46 AMPC

42 Saying, What do you think of the Christ? Whose Son is He? They said to Him, The Son of David.

43 He said to them, How is it then that David, under the influence of the [Holy] Spirit, calls Him Lord, saying,

44 The Lord said to My Lord, Sit at My right hand until I put Your enemies under Your feet?

45 If then David thus calls Him Lord, how is He his Son?

46 And no one was able to answer Him a word, <u>nor from that day did</u> <u>anyone venture or dare to question Him.</u>

There is an abundance of information in the Bible that often, we glance over, don't give a second thought to, don't think it is significant but that is why we study the Bible. The revelation of the information leads to transformation. The work or proof that the Holy Spirit does when He is within us is a transformed life.

How old is the earth according to God who made it? 6,000 years old. When Jesus said Adam and Eve were created in the beginning when everything was created.... Should He of checked with the scientists who carbon date first? Why didn't Jesus first consult with those who don't believe that God crated them? Who don't believe that the entire Bible is true?

Job 38:4, 18 AMPC

4 Where were you when I laid the foundation of the earth? 18 ... Tell Me, if you know it all.

Remember this is what Paul wrote to the church...

<u>Romans 5:12 KJV</u>

12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

Romans 5:12 AMPC

12 Therefore, as sin came into the world through one man, and death as the result of sin, so death spread to all men, [[a]no one being able to stop it or to escape its power] because all men sinned.

Death didn't enter the world until Adam was created... no "thing" before him. No other humans, no caveman... no "thing" had ever died before.

<u>1 Corinthians 15:21-22 AMPC</u>

21 For since [it was] through a man that death [came into the world, it is] also through a Man that the resurrection of the dead [has come].
22 For just as [because of their [a]union of nature] in Adam all people die, so also [by virtue of their [b]union of nature] shall all in Christ be made alive.

The Bible is not ambiguous, not confusing, not trying to deceive or open up a discussion on the age of the earth. Paul even reminded the church that Adam was the first man.

<u>1 Corinthians 15:45 AMPC</u>

45 Thus it is written, The first man Adam became a living being (an individual personality); the last Adam (Christ) became a life-giving Spirit [restoring the dead to life].

Genesis 3:20 AMPC

20 The man called his wife's name Eve [life spring], <u>because she was</u> the mother of all the living.

Death did enter the world until Adam and Eve was the mother of all living...

The Evolutionary theory has the sun and stars evolving before the earth...God said in Genesis 1 that He created the earth before the sun and stars. Everything about evolution is opposite to the Bible.

Man thinks it knows so much about everything outside of God, this is what God said to Job...


Job 12:8 AMPC

8 Or speak to the earth [with its other forms of life], and it will teach you; and the fish of the sea will declare [this truth] to you.

Here's a truth that the earth can teach us. The earth's magnetic strength has declined 10% in the last 150 years and 40% in the lat 1,000 years. Since it is getting weaker, that means it used to be stronger. Just the earth magnetic decline limits it to a max of 25,000 years old which also means carbon dating cant work for more then just a few thousand years.

For example, the lower leg of the Fairbanks Creek mammoth had a radio carbon age of 15,000 years while it's skin and flesh were 21,300 years old. In Glaciated Central Alaska, the Geological Survey Professional paper stated "one part of the Vollosovitch mammoth carbon dates at 29,5000 years and another part at 44,000 years.

There is another theory called Pangaea, this is where it is claimed that all the continents were connected together...



Those who believe in this theory (non fact) don't tell you is they have to shrink Africa 35% to make everything fit. You need to take out Mexica and Central America as well. Panama, Costa Rica, Honduras, Belize, Nicaragua... all countries I have been in while I served overseas in the United States Air Force.

A common thought from this theory is that if you take the water out they would somehow just squish together... well, if you take all the water away these continents are still connected by dirt. 
Scientists tell us that the earth's rotating is slowing down and it is, one second every year. If God's Word is true then 1 second per year for 6,000 years would not be that noticeable but if it was billions of years old....we got a big problem. It was day then night every millisecond. Can you imagine how fast the earth used to spin using this theory (no facts)? The winds alone from the spinning would be over 5,000 mph and that is when the dinosaurs lived? It is really hard to have a desert underneath a flood. So, the desert could not have existed until the flood water went down. Based on God's Word, the oldest desert in the world will be less than 4,400 years old. It is amazing how science proves the Bible to be true. When you drill down far enough into the earth, sometimes you can hit oil. The oil is under immense pressure and in some places it can reach as high as 20,000 PSI. Scientists tell us that rocks can only hold that pressure for no more than 10,000 years or less.

So, here's a couple of questions... where did the oil come from? And, why is it still under pressure? Scientists agree that oil and gas are from organisms that once lived in the seas and change by heat and pressure into oil.

If oil can only be under pressure for no more then 10,000 years and it's from animals but scientist tell us that the oil is from dinosaurs millions of years ago... that doesn't make sense.

When the flood occurred all the animals other then what was on the Ark got squished under all the water, sludge and mud and the pressure after 4,4000 years has turned into the oil that we use today.

<u>1 Peter 3:14-17 AMPC</u>

14 But even in case you should suffer for the sake of righteousness, [you are] blessed (happy, to be envied). Do not dread or be afraid of their threats, nor be disturbed [by their opposition].

15 But in your hearts set Christ apart as holy [and acknowledge Him] as Lord. Always be ready to give a logical defense to anyone who asks you to account for the hope that is in you, but do it courteously and respectfully. 16 [And see to it that] your conscience is entirely clear ([a]unimpaired), so that, when you are falsely accused as evildoers, those who threaten you abusively and revile your right behavior in Christ may come to be ashamed [of slandering your good lives].

17 For [it is] better to suffer [unjustly] for doing right, if that should be God's will, than to suffer [justly] for doing wrong.

<u>2 Peter 1:19-20 AMPC</u>

19 <u>And we have the prophetic word [made] firmer still.</u> You will do well to pay close attention to it as to a lamp shining in a dismal (squalid and dark) place, until the day breaks through [the gloom] and the Morning Star rises ([a]comes into being) in your hearts.

20 [Yet] first [you must] understand this, that no prophecy of Scripture is [a matter] of any personal or private or special interpretation (loosening, solving).

Science continues to prove the Bible is true!
