

Luke 21:25 AMPC

25 And there will be signs in the sun and moon and stars; and <u>upon the</u> <u>earth [there will be] distress (trouble and anguish) of nations in</u> <u>bewilderment and perplexity [without resources, left wanting,</u> <u>embarrassed, in doubt, not knowing which way to turn] at the roaring</u> (the echo) of the tossing of the sea,

Jesus said the when we get into the last season of the birth pains, the latter days of the End of Time that the seas will be roaring. But, people in the church will be mocking and scoffing those who believe God's Word is true regarding: sin, judgment, righteousness and the things (sings) to come that were prophesied that must occur.

<u>2 Peter 3:1-6 AMPC</u>

1 Beloved, I am now writing you this second letter. In [both of] them I have stirred up your unsullied (sincere) mind by way of remembrance,

2 That you should <u>recall the predictions of the holy (consecrated,</u> <u>dedicated) prophets</u> and the commandment of the Lord and Savior [given] through your apostles (His special messengers).

3 To begin with, you must know and understand this, that <u>scoffers</u> (mockers) will come in the last days with scoffing, [people who] walk after their own fleshly desires 4 And say, <u>Where is the promise of His</u> <u>coming?</u> For since the forefathers fell asleep, all things have continued exactly as they did from the beginning of creation.

5 For they <u>willfully overlook and forget this [fact]</u>, that the heavens [came into] existence long ago by the word of God, and the earth also which was formed out of water and by means of water,

6 <u>Through which the world that then [existed] was deluged with water</u> <u>and perished.</u>

<u>2 Peter 3:11-18 AMPC</u>

11 Since all these things are thus [b]in the process of being dissolved, what kind of person ought [each of] you to be [in the meanwhile] in consecrated and holy behavior and devout and godly qualities,

12 While you wait and earnestly long for (expect and hasten) the coming of the day of God by reason of which the flaming heavens will be dissolved, and the [[c]material] elements [of the universe] will flare and melt with fire?

13 But we look for new heavens and a new earth according to His promise, in which righteousness (uprightness, freedom from sin, and right standing with God) is to abide.

14 So, beloved, since you are expecting these things, be eager to be found by Him [at His coming] without spot or blemish and at peace [in serene confidence, [d]free from fears and agitating passions and moral conflicts]. 15 And consider that the long-suffering of our Lord [[e]His slowness in avenging wrongs and judging the world] is salvation ([f]that which is conducive to the soul's safety), even as our beloved brother Paul also wrote to you according to the spiritual insight given him,

16 Speaking of this as he does in all of his letters. There are some things in those [epistles of Paul] that are difficult to understand, which the ignorant and unstable twist and misconstrue to their own [g]utter destruction, just as [they distort and misinterpret] the rest of the Scriptures.

17 Let me warn you therefore, beloved, that knowing these things beforehand, you should be on your guard, lest you be carried away by the error of lawless and wicked [persons and] fall from your own [present] firm condition [your own steadfastness of mind].

18 But grow in grace (undeserved favor, spiritual strength) and [h]recognition and knowledge and understanding of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (the Messiah). To Him [be] glory (honor, majesty, and splendor) both now and to the day of eternity. Amen (so be it)!

Note:

<u>2 Peter 1:1-9 AMPC</u>

1 Simon Peter, a servant and apostle (special messenger) of Jesus Christ, <u>to those who have received (obtained an equal privilege of) like</u> <u>precious faith with ourselves in and through the righteousness of our</u> <u>God and Savior Jesus Christ:</u>

2 May grace (God's favor) and peace (which is [a]perfect well-being, all necessary good, all spiritual prosperity, and [b]freedom from fears and agitating passions and moral conflicts) be multiplied to you in [the full, personal, [c]precise, and correct] knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. 3 For His divine power has bestowed upon us all things that [are requisite and suited] to life and godliness, through the [[d]full, personal] knowledge of Him Who called us by and to His own glory and excellence (virtue). 4 By means of these He has bestowed on us His precious and exceedingly great promises, so that through them you may escape [by flight] from the moral decay (rottenness and corruption) that is in the world because of covetousness (lust and greed), and become sharers (partakers) of the divine nature.

5 For this very reason, [e]adding your diligence [to the divine promises], employ every effort in [f**]exercising** your faith to develop virtue (excellence, resolution, Christian energy), and in [exercising] virtue [develop] knowledge (intelligence),

6 And in [<u>exercising]</u> knowledge [develop] self-control, and in [<u>exercising]</u> self-control [develop] steadfastness (patience, endurance), and in [<u>exercising]</u> steadfastness [develop] godliness (piety),

7 And in [<u>exercising]</u> godliness [develop] brotherly affection, and in [<u>exercising]</u> brotherly affection [develop] Christian love.

8 For as these qualities are yours and increasingly abound in you, they will keep [you] from being idle or unfruitful unto the [[g]full personal] knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One).

9 For <u>whoever lacks these qualities is blind, [[h]spiritually]</u> <u>shortsighted,</u> [i]seeing only what is near to him, and has become oblivious [to the fact] that he was cleansed from his old sins. Note:

<u>2 Peter 1:12-21 AMPC</u>

12 So *I intend always to remind you about these things,* although indeed you know them and are firm in the truth that [you] now [hold].

<u>13 I think it right, as long as I am in this tabernacle (tent, body), to stir</u> you up by way of remembrance,

<u>14 Since I know that the laying aside of this body of mine will come</u> <u>speedily, as our Lord Jesus Christ made clear to me.</u>

<u>15 Moreover, I will diligently endeavor [to see to it] that [even] after</u> <u>my departure (decease) you may be able at all times to call these things</u> <u>to mind.</u>

16 For we were not following cleverly devised stories when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah), but we were eyewitnesses of His majesty (grandeur, authority of sovereign power).

17 For when He was invested with honor and glory from God the Father and a voice was borne to Him by the [splendid] Majestic Glory [in the bright cloud that overshadowed Him, saying], This is My beloved Son in Whom I am well pleased and delight,

18 We [actually] heard this voice borne out of heaven, for we were together with Him on the holy mountain.

19 And we have the prophetic word [made] firmer still. You will do well to pay close attention to it as to a lamp shining in a dismal (squalid and dark) place, until the day breaks through [the gloom] and the Morning Star rises ([j]comes into being) in your hearts.

20 [Yet] first [you must] understand this, that no prophecy of Scripture is [a matter] of any personal or private or special interpretation (loosening, solving).

<u>21 For no prophecy ever originated because some man willed it [to do</u> so—it never came by human impulse], but men spoke from God who were borne along (moved and impelled) by the Holy Spirit.

Note:

John 1 AMPC

1 In the beginning [before all time] was the Word ([a]Christ), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God [b]Himself.

2 He was present originally with God.

3 All things were made and came into existence through Him; and without Him was not even one thing made that has come into being.

4 In Him was Life, and the Life was the Light of men.

5 And the Light shines on in the darkness, for the darkness has never overpowered it [put it out or absorbed it or appropriated it, and is unreceptive to it].

6 There came a man sent from God, whose name was John.

7 This man came to witness, that he might testify of the Light, that all men might believe in it [adhere to it, trust it, and rely upon it] through him.

8 He was not the Light himself, but came that he might bear witness regarding the Light.

<u>9 There it was—the true Light [was then] coming into the world [the genuine, perfect, steadfast Light] that illumines every person.</u>

<u>10 He came into the world, and though the world was made through</u> Him, the world did not recognize Him [did not know Him].

<u>11 He came to that which belonged to Him [to His own—His domain, creation, things, world], and they who were His own did not receive Him and did not welcome Him.</u>

Note: ______

<u>12 But to as many as did receive and welcome Him, He gave the authority (power, privilege, right) to become the children of God, that is, to those who believe in (adhere to, trust in, and rely on) His name</u>

<u>13 Who owe their birth neither to [c]bloods nor to the will of the flesh</u> [that of physical impulse] nor to the will of man [that of a natural father], but to God. [They are born of God!]

14 And the Word (Christ) became flesh (human, incarnate) and tabernacled (fixed His tent of flesh, lived awhile) among us; and we [actually] saw His glory (His honor, His majesty), such glory as an only begotten son receives from his father, full of grace (favor, lovingkindness) and truth.

15 John testified about Him and cried out, This was He of Whom I said, He Who comes after me has priority over me, for He was before me. [He takes rank above me, for He existed before I did. He has advanced before me, because He is my Chief.]

16 For out of His fullness (abundance) we have all received [all had a share and we were all supplied with] one grace after another and spiritual blessing upon spiritual blessing and even favor upon favor and gift [heaped] upon gift.

17 For while the Law was given through Moses, grace ([d]unearned, undeserved favor and spiritual blessing) and truth came through Jesus Christ.

18 No man has ever seen God at any time; the only [e]unique Son, or [f]the only begotten God, Who is in the bosom [in the intimate presence] of the Father, He has declared Him [He has revealed Him and brought Him out where He can be seen; He has interpreted Him and He has made Him known].

19 And this is the testimony of John when the Jews sent priests and Levites to him from Jerusalem to ask him, Who are you?

20 He confessed (admitted the truth) and did not try to conceal it, but acknowledged, I am not the Christ!

21 They asked him, What then? Are you Elijah? And he said, I am not! Are you the Prophet? And he answered, No!

22 Then they said to him, Who are you? Tell us, so that we may give an answer to those who sent us. What do you say about yourself?

23 He said, I am the voice of one crying aloud in the wilderness [the voice of one shouting in the desert], Prepare the way of the Lord [level, straighten out, the path of the Lord], as the prophet Isaiah said.

Note:

24 The messengers had been sent from the Pharisees.

25 And they asked him, Why then are you baptizing if you are not the Christ, nor Elijah, nor the Prophet?

26 John answered them, I [only] baptize [g]in (with) water. Among you there stands One Whom you do not recognize and with Whom you are not acquainted and of Whom you know nothing.

27 It is He Who, coming after me, is preferred before me, the string of Whose sandal I am not worthy to unloose.

28 These things occurred in Bethany (Bethabara) across the Jordan [[h]at the Jordan crossing], where John was then baptizing.

29 The next day John saw Jesus coming to him and said, Look! There is the Lamb of God, Who takes away the sin of the world!

<u>30 This is He of Whom I said, After me comes a Man Who has priority</u> over me [Who takes rank above me] because He was before me and existed before I did.

Note: _____

<u>31 And I did not know Him and did not recognize Him [myself]; but it is in order that He should be made manifest and be revealed to Israel [be brought out where we can see Him] that I came baptizing [i]in (with) water.</u>

<u>32 John gave further evidence, saying, I have seen the Spirit</u> <u>descending as a dove out of heaven, and it dwelt on Him [never to</u> <u>depart].</u> 33 And I did not know Him nor recognize Him, but He Who sent me to baptize [j]in (with) water said to me, Upon Him Whom you shall see the Spirit descend and remain, that One is He Who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.

<u>34 And I have seen [that happen—I actually did see it] and my</u> <u>testimony is that this is the Son of God!</u>

Note: _____

37 The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Him.

38 But Jesus turned, and as He saw them following Him, He said to them, What are you looking for? [And what is it you wish?] And they answered Him, Rabbi—which translated is Teacher—where are You staying?

39 He said to them, Come and see. So they went and saw where He was staying, and they remained with Him [k] that day. It was then about the tenth hour (about four o'clock in the afternoon).

40 One of the two who heard what John said and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.

41 He first sought out and found his own brother Simon and said to him, We have found (discovered) the Messiah!—which translated is the Christ (the Anointed One).

42 Andrew then led (brought) Simon to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, You are Simon son of John. You shall be called Cephas—which translated is Peter [Stone].

43 The next day Jesus desired and decided to go into Galilee; and He found Philip and said to him, Join Me as My attendant and follow Me. 44 Now Philip was from Bethsaida, of the same city as Andrew and Peter. 45 Philip sought and found Nathanael and told him, We have found (discovered) the One Moses in the Law and also the Prophets wrote about—Jesus from Nazareth, the [legal] son of Joseph! 46 Nathanael answered him, [Nazareth!] Can anything good come out of Nazareth? Philip replied, Come and see!

Note:

47 Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward Him and said concerning him, See! Here is an Israelite indeed [a true descendant of Jacob], in whom there is no guile nor deceit nor falsehood nor duplicity!

48 Nathanael said to Jesus, How do You know me? [How is it that You know these things about me?] Jesus answered him, Before [ever] Philip called you, when you were still under the fig tree, I saw you.

49 Nathanael answered, Teacher, You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!

50 Jesus replied, Because I said to you, I saw you beneath the fig tree, do you believe in and rely on and trust in Me? You shall see greater things than this!

51 Then He said to him, I assure you, most solemnly I tell you all, you shall see heaven opened, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man!

Note:

There are signs that are listed in God's Word that will take place in their fullness in the 7 year tribulation ...so, when we see them beginning to take place or forming, the Bible says "get ready to go!"

Matthew 24:1-8 AMPC

1 Jesus departed from the temple [a]area and was going on His way when His disciples came up to Him to call His attention to the buildings of the temple and point them out to Him.

2 But He answered them, Do you see all these? Truly I tell you, there will not be left here one stone upon another that will not be thrown down.

3 While He was seated on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately and said, Tell us, when will this take place, and <u>what will</u> <u>be the sign of Your coming and of the end (the completion, the</u> <u>consummation) of the age?</u>

4 Jesus answered them, Be careful that no one misleads you [deceiving you and leading you into error].

<u>5 For many will come in (on the strength of) My name</u> [[b]appropriating the name which belongs to Me], saying, I am the Christ (the Messiah), and they will lead many astray.

6 <u>And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars</u>; see that you are not frightened or troubled, <u>for this must take place, but the end is not yet.</u>

7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in place after place;

8 <u>All this is but the beginning [the early pains] of the [c]birth pangs [of</u> <u>the [d]intolerable anguish].</u>


Let's get back to what Jesus said would be the birth pains that we would see coming to pass...

Luke 21:25 AMPC


25 And there will be signs in the sun and moon and stars; and <u>upon the</u> <u>earth [there will be] distress (trouble and anguish) of nations in</u> <u>bewilderment and perplexity [without resources, left wanting,</u> <u>embarrassed, in doubt, not knowing which way to turn] at the roaring</u> (the echo) of the tossing of the sea.

In part 3 we studied God's Word about the volcanic eruptions, fire and brimstone, the ground shaking or earthquakes and mountains falling into the sea causing death, seas to be read, ships destroyed.

The roaring of the sea (echo) of the sea is what is used today to describe the sound prior to a tsunamis hitting land. These tsunamis are caused by mountains, land mass falling into the sea and or earthquakes in the ocean floor or coastlands. Below are maps and images of the active fault lines that are on "the coastlands"... this was foretold in the Old/New Testament.



Map of the Earth above shows fault lines (blue) and zones of volcanic activity (red)



God's Word promises that we will see and feel some of the birth pains before the terrible day of the Lord in order to wake us up that Jesus is coming. Jesus said we will see these "things" coming so, stay awake, alert and be found habitually righteous if you want to escape these things that will come upon all that remain on the face of the earth. This was foretold by Jesus, Peter, Paul and John along with the Old Testament Prophets.

The New Testament writers are End Times preachers, they told you and I about sin, judgment, righteousness and the things or signs to watch for prior to Jesus coming in the clouds and the end of the 7 year tribulation.

<u>Revelation 16 AMPC</u>

1 Then I heard a mighty voice from the temple sanctuary saying to the seven angels, Go and empty out on the earth the seven bowls of God's wrath and indignation.

2 So the first [angel] went and emptied his bowl on the earth, and <u>foul</u> and painful ulcers (sores) came on the people who were marked with the stamp of the beast and who did homage to his image.

3 The second [angel] emptied his bowl into <u>the sea, and it turned into</u> <u>blood like that of a corpse [thick, corrupt, ill-smelling, and disgusting],</u> <u>and every living thing that was in the sea perished.</u>

4 Then the third [angel] emptied out his bowl into <u>the rivers and the</u> <u>springs of water, and they turned into (became) blood.</u>

5 And I also heard <u>the angel of the waters say, Righteous (just) are You</u> <u>in these Your decisions and judgments, You Who are and were, O Holy</u> <u>One!</u>

6 <u>Because they have poured out the blood of Your people (the saints)</u> and the prophets, and You have given them blood to drink. Such is their due [they deserve it]!

7 And [from] the altar I heard [the] cry, Yes, Lord God the Omnipotent, Your judgments (sentences, decisions) are true and just and righteous! 8 Then the fourth [angel] emptied out his bowl upon t<u>he sun, and it was</u> permitted to burn (scorch) humanity with [fierce, glowing] heat (fire). 9 <u>People were severely burned (scorched) by the fiery heat, and they</u> reviled and blasphemed the name of God, Who has control of these plagues, and they did not repent of their sins [felt no regret, contrition, and compunction for their waywardness, refusing to amend their ways] to give Him glory.

10 Then the fifth [angel] emptied his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom was [plunged] in darkness; and <u>people gnawed their</u> <u>tongues for the torment [of their excruciating distress and severe pain]</u> 11 <u>And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their anguish and</u> <u>their ulcers (sores), and they did not deplore their wicked</u> <u>deeds or repent [for what they had done].</u>

12 <u>Then the sixth [angel] emptied his bowl on the mighty river</u> <u>Euphrates, and its water was dried up to make ready a road for [the</u> <u>coming of] the kings of the east (from the rising sun).</u>

13 And I saw three loathsome spirits like frogs, [leaping] from the mouth of the dragon and from the mouth of the beast and from the mouth of the false prophet.

14 For really they are the spirits of demons that perform signs (wonders, miracles). And they go forth to the rulers and leaders all over the world, to gather them together for war on the great day of God the Almighty.

15 <u>Behold, I am going to come like a thief</u>! <u>Blessed (happy, [a]to be envied) is he who stays awake (alert) and who guards his clothes, so that he may not be naked and [have the shame of being] seen exposed</u>! 16 <u>And they gathered them together at the place which in Hebrew is called Armageddon.</u>

17 Then the seventh [angel] emptied out his bowl into the air, and a mighty voice came out of the sanctuary of heaven from the throne [of God], saying, It is done! [It is all over, it is all accomplished, it has come!]

18 <u>And there followed lightning flashes, loud rumblings, peals of</u> <u>thunder, and a tremendous earthquake; nothing like it has ever</u> <u>occurred since men dwelt on the earth, so severe and far-reaching was</u> <u>that earthquake.</u> 19 The mighty city was broken into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. And God kept in mind mighty Babylon, to make her drain the cup of His furious wrath and indignation.

20 <u>And every island fled and no mountains could be found.</u> <u>21 And great (excessively oppressive) hailstones, as heavy as a talent</u> [between fifty and sixty pounds], of immense size, fell from the sky on the people; and men blasphemed God for the plague of the hail, so very great was [the torture] of that plague.



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
