2 Peter 3:1-6 AMPC

- I Beloved, I am now writing you this second letter. In [both of] them I have stirred up your unsullied (sincere) mind by way of remembrance,
- 2 That you should <u>recall the predictions of the holy (consecrated, dedicated) prophets and the commandment of the Lord and Savior [given] through your apostles (His special messengers).</u>
- 3 To begin with, you must know and understand this, that <u>scoffers</u> (mockers) will come in the last days with scoffing, [people who] walk after their own fleshly desires
- 4 And say, Where is the promise of His coming? For since the forefathers fell asleep, all things have continued exactly as they did from the beginning of creation.
- 5 For they willfully overlook and forget this [fact], that the heavens [came into] existence long ago by the word of Go, and the earth also which was formed out of water and by means of water,
- 6 <u>Through which the world that then [existed] was deluged with water and perished.</u>

Colossians 2:8 AMPC

8 See to it that <u>no one carries you off</u> as spoil or makes you yourselves captive by his <u>so-called philosophy and intellectualism</u> and vain deceit (idle fancies and plain nonsense), following human tradition (men's ideas of the material rather than the spiritual world), just crude notions <u>following the rudimentary and elemental teachings of the universe and disregarding [the teachings of] Christ (the Messiah).</u>

1 Peter 3:14-17 AMPC

14 But even in case you should suffer for the sake of righteousness, [you are] blessed (happy, to be envied). Do not dread or be afraid of their threats, nor be disturbed [by their opposition].

15 But in your hearts set Christ apart as holy [and acknowledge Him] as Lord. Always be ready to give a logical defense to anyone who asks you to account for the hope that is in you, but do it courteously and respectfully.

16 [And see to it that] your conscience is entirely clear ([a]unimpaired), so that, when you are falsely accused as evildoers, those who threaten you abusively and revile your right behavior in Christ may come to be ashamed [of slandering your good lives].

17 For [it is] better to suffer [unjustly] for doing right, if that should be God's will, than to suffer [justly] for doing wrong.

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<u> 2 Peter 1:19-20 AMPC</u>

19 <u>And we have the prophetic word [made] firmer still.</u> You will do well to pay close attention to it as to a lamp shining in a dismal (squalid and dark) place, until the day breaks through [the gloom] and the Morning Star rises ([a]comes into being) in your hearts.

Science continues to prove the Bible is true...

<u>Psalm 119:130 AMPC</u>

130 The entrance and <u>unfolding of Your words give light</u>; their unfolding <u>gives understanding (discernment and comprehension)</u> to the simple.

<u>Psalm 119:105 KJV</u>

105 Thy word is **a lamp** unto my feet, and **a light** unto my path.

The psalmist wrote...

Psalm 8:3 AMPC

3 <u>When I view and consider</u> Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained and established.

He sat down and considered, thought about, contemplated, reflected etc.

What a great idea, let us, you and I stop life, sit down and consider God's Word. All the things that are written in it about our lives, our eternity and how we are to live habitually (according to His command and instructions in the Word) in order to spend eternity with HIM.

As followers or imitators of Jesus Christ we are commanded to "go be my witness" and "go make disciples". In order to do that is important to know God's Word and what are the stumbling blocks, the "I can't wrap my head around" this *things* that people have.

This is what the Apostle Paul said...

1 Corinthians 9:15-27 AMPC

- 19 For although I am free in every way from anyone's control, I have made myself a bond servant to everyone, so that I might gain the more [for Christ].
- 20 To the Jews <u>I became as a Jew, that I might win Jews</u>; to men under the Law, [I became] <u>as one under the Law,</u> though not myself being under the Law, <u>that I might win those under the Law.</u>
- 21 To those without (outside) law <u>I became as one without law, not that</u> <u>I am without the law of God and lawless toward Him</u>, but that I am [especially keeping] within and committed to the law of Christ, <u>that I might win those who are without law.</u>
- 22 To the weak (wanting in discernment) I have become weak (wanting in discernment) that I might win the weak and overscrupulous. I have [in short] become all things to all men, that I might by all means (at all costs and in any and every way) save some [by winning them to faith in Jesus Christ].
- 23 And I do this for the sake of the good news (the Gospel), in order that I may become a participator in it and share in its [blessings along with you].
- 24 Do you not know that in a race all the runners compete, but [only] one receives the prize? So run [your race] that you may lay hold [of the prize] and make it yours. 25 Now every athlete who goes into training conducts himself temperately and restricts himself in all things. They do it to win a wreath that will soon wither, but we [do it to receive a crown of eternal blessedness] that cannot wither.
- 26 Therefore I do not run uncertainly (without definite aim). I do not box like one beating the air and striking without an adversary.
- 27 But [like a boxer] I buffet my body [handle it roughly, discipline it by hardships] and subdue it, for fear that after proclaiming to others the Gospel and things pertaining to it, I myself should become unfit [not stand the test, be unapproved and rejected as a counterfeit].

Galatians 1:10 AMPC

10 Now <u>am I trying to win the favor of men, or of God?</u> Do I seek to please men? <u>If I were still seeking popularity with men, I should not be a bond servant of Christ (the Messiah).</u>

We are studying God's Word and the entrance of His Word(s) brings light. Light or awareness or a revelation to "things" in our lives found in His Word(s). Paul said I "became as" or "thought like" (mused) the person that is before me that needs Jesus or needs to grow in the knowledge of His Word so I could answer the questions they have.

One of the stumbling blocks for people is *creation science* and by finding out the answers to reach them, we have been studying the Word ourselves proving and making His Word firmer still in our lives. All the answers to life's questions are found in the pages of His Word.

As we have gone thru this series remembering and learning about what has been and is being taught in the education system, it is not a surprise why people do not believe God's Word is true or many parts of it. Remember if it's not all true then none of it is... you can't pick and choose what parts you believe and act on, Jesus said I am the way, the truth and the life, the whole truth and nothing but the Truth.

One of the areas that churched and unchurched people are confused about or have questions about is dinosaurs. From science magazines, history channels and even magazines in the dentist office where you will find the National Geographic from January 1993 has stories about "no human being has ever seen a live dinosaur."

Just that statement alone... "let us muse" like David did. Does that scientist know that or think that? "no human being has ever seen a live dinosaur." He thinks that, because there's no way a person could know that unless they talked to everyone who has ever lived.

Romans 1:22-32 AMPC

22 Claiming to be wise, they became fools [professing to be smart, they made simpletons of themselves].

Who did this scientist ask before he wrote that 'no one has ever seen a dinosaur'? Did he ask me? You? People in the 1600's? Adam and Eve?

Just because someone believes "it" to be true doesn't make it true.

Genesis 1:1 KJV

1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

....and for those who try and make the 6 days of creation in Genesis say something other that a 24 hour day because the *sun and moon* was not created until.... because grass can't grow... becuase....Here's some information from the "Never Wrong" Prophet Moses who states the days of creation after a 24 hour day has been established.

Exodus 20:11 KJV

11 For <u>in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all</u> that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

Exodus 20:11 AMPC

11 For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. That is why the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it [set it apart for His purposes].

This is part of the 10 commandments and the giving of the Ten Commandments was supernatural. Remember Moses threw down the first set of tablets because of the sin the people committed while he was in the mountain receiving them.

Deuteronomy 9:9 KJV

9 When I was gone up into the mount to receive the tables of stone, even the tables of the covenant which the Lord made with you, then I abode in the mount forty days and forty nights, I neither did eat bread nor drink water:

Deuteronomy 9:9-10 AMPC

9 When I went up the mountain to receive the tables of stone, the tables of the covenant which the Lord made with you, I remained on the mountain forty days and forty nights; I neither ate food nor drank water.

10 And the Lord delivered to me the two tables of stone written with the finger of God; and on them were all the words which the Lord spoke with you on the mountain out of the midst of the fire in the day of the assembly.

Deuteronomy 10:1-2 AMPC

1 At that time the Lord said to me, Hew two tables of stone like the first and come up to Me on the mountain and make an ark of wood.

2 And I will write on the tables the words that were on the first tables which you broke, and you shall put them in the ark.

So, if in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them... that means that Adam saw dinosaurs. Remember, there was no death before Adam and Eve was the mother of all living things. But, the textbooks says the dinosaurs died before man evolved here on the earth. Somebody is wrong...

Genesis 1:6 KJV


6 And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.

Genesis 1:6 AMPC

6 And God said, Let there be a firmament [the expanse of the sky] in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters [below] from the waters [above].



There used to be a layer of water above the atmosphere, was it ice? Was it a solid, liquid or gas? I don't know how it was up there, I just know the Bible is true and it states there was water up in the firmament.



The Bible also tells us that much of the water in the oceans used to be under the crust of the earth. Many scientists believe because of testing that there is an ocean underneath the ocean. Sounds like the Bible is being made firmer still. (2 Peter 1:19)

Psalm 24:1-2 KJV

- 24 The earth is the Lord's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.
- 2 For he hath founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the floods.

Psalm 136:6 KJV

6 To him that stretched out the earth above the waters: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Most of the water in the oceans used to be under the crust found in subterranean water chambers. When Adam and Eve were here, the earth was mostly land (that is what I believe) and after the flood it is now 70% water but only 3% of the earth is inhabitable for mankind. (From deserts, ice caps and or underwater).

At the time of the flood, the fountains of the deep burst from the crust of the earth and flooded much of the earth. - the low lying areas.

Genesis 8:1-2 KJV

- I And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that was with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters assuaged;
- 2 <u>The fountains also of the deep</u> and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained;

From the time of creation (6,000 years ago) to the time of the flood (4,400 years ago) life was very different. The average age of man was over 900 years (912 according to genealogies) before the flood. Can you imagine what you could learn living 900 years? For instance, we know that Adam spoke all the languages on the earth at that time....

One of the things that we know or have learned is that reptiles never stop growing. They continue to grow their entire life but people stop growing vertically usually by the age of 20 years old... that is measurable, testable and observable.

So, what would happen to a reptile if they lived 900 years? Just like all reptiles that grow throughout their life, dinosaurs were big lizards that lived with Adam and Eve not just before the flood but after. They did not live millions and billions of years ago. Remember, there were pre-flood not pre-historic.

I have heard godly pastors, preachers and teachers answer when asked the questions were dinosaurs on the ark answer no, they died before man got here... well now you have death before sin. That is contrary to the Bible.

I know people say they are too big... ok, so what did Noah do with the wood peckers? Put them in a steel cage? Do you think God can figure things out that maybe we have never thought of?

Matthew 19:26 AMPC

26 But Jesus looked at them and said, <u>With men this is impossible, but</u> <u>all things are possible with God.</u>

Romans 1:22 AMPC

22 Claiming to be wise, they became fools [professing to be smart, they made simpletons of themselves].

So, how did dinosaurs fit on the ark or any large animal? Well, the big ones were big and the little ones were little.

Noah was 600 years old when he built the ark and I think he may of been smart enough to figure out that you have to bring the smallest animals you can find. The size was not the important part, it was male and female which would be vital... as it was in the beginning so shall it be in the end (Isaiah 46) or there is nothing new under the sun (Ecclesiastes 1:9).

Why bring babies or smaller animals? They weigh less, eat less, sleep more and they are tougher. Plus, the younger they are the longer they will live after the flood so they will be able to produce longer which is why you are bringing them, to multiply.

Remember, God instructed Noah to bring 2 of every sort and not every single type of variety... just 2 of the basic kinds or sort of animals

Genesis 6:19 KJV

19 And of every living thing of all flesh, <u>two of every sort</u> shalt thou bring into the ark, to keep them alive with thee; they shall be male and female.

Genesis 7:14-15 KJV

14 They, and every beast <u>after his kind</u>, and all the cattle after their kind, and every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind, and every fowl <u>after his kind</u>, every bird of <u>every sort</u>.

15 And they went in unto Noah into the ark, two and two of all flesh, wherein is the breath of life.

The Bible is clear on what Noah was instructed to bring on the ark - 2 of every basic kinds or sorts of animals. He was also told to only bring the kinds with...

Genesis 7:22 KJV

22 All in whose <u>nostrils was the breath of life</u>, of all that was <u>in the dry</u> <u>land</u>

Noah did not have to bring any fish on the ark...they're going to be fine.

He didn't have to bring any bugs on the ark because bugs don't have nostrils, they breathe through spiracles in their skin. Bugs survive on dead carcasses floating, wood that is floating or burrowed in the mud.

Noah was instructed to bring 2 of every generic kind of animal on the ark and they would micro evolved into what we have today. From different kinds of dogs not species. Noah probably never had a golden doodle, a chihuahua, cockapoo or labrodoodle... these are not macro but micro evolution... this is measurable testable and observable - all dogs.

Noah was told be bring 2 of every kind and not every species or variety on the ark. There is approximate 8,000 kinds of animals and if you talked 60 words per minute you could name all of them in 2 hours. Adam named all the animals - Bible says so.

Genesis 2:18-21 KJV

18 And the Lord God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.

19 And out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof.

20 And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him. 21 And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;

Adam gave names to all cattle, to the birds of the air, and to every beast of the field. But, Adam didn't name every variety and species of animal. He only named the "kinds" of animals that God brought to him. (All of the varieties and species would not have been there yet!) In other words, he only named the dog kind, the cat kind, the horse kind, etc.

When Adam was born he was already preprogrammed: he could walk, talk, get married and name animals in his first week alive.

How big was the ark? Why did all of this have to happen?

<u>Genesis 6:11-14 KJV</u>

11 The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.

12 And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was **corrupt**; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.

13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

14 Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.

After the flood one of Noah's sons Shem had a son and named him Arphaxad (Genesis 10:22). Not only did Shem tell his son what happened to all the people (why there wasn't more) but Shem would live long enough to tell Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in person.

Today there are over 270 surviving flood legends, people are still telling stories about the flood in many cultures that have never heard about the Biblical Flood.

In Hawaii... "Long after the death of Kuniuhonna, the first man, the world became a wicked terrible place to live. There was one good man left: his name was Nu-u. He made a great canoe with a home on it and filled it with animals. The waters came up over all the earth and killed all the people. Only Hu-u and his family were saved."

One family and animals saved in a giant canoe... sounds like Noah and the Ark from the Bible.

In China... Their history records that Fuji, his wife, three sons and there daughters escaped a great flood. He and his family were the only people alive on earth. After the great flood they repopulated the world.

...sounds like Noah and the Ark from the Bible.

The Toltec Indians of ancient Mexico said, "the first world lasted 1716 years and was destroyed by a great flood that covered the highest mountains." Only one family named survived.

...sounds like Noah and the Ark from the Bible. The Bible dates the flood about 1600 years after creation which is not bad for the Coxcox legend after the flood 4400 years ago.

There is countless stories of a flood in all cultures dating back to thousands of years ago - not millions. These are stories of a man and his wife with children and animals being saved by a world wide flood.

I have a theory... about 6,000 years ago God created everything. I have a theory... about 4,400 years ago there was a flood.

I want to give you some things to *muse* about over the next week...

The word Dinosaur: was coined in 1841 and it originates from two greek words deinos – terrible, powerful, wondrous and sauros – lizard. Before 1841 these animals were referred to as dragons or large lizards.

The word Unicorn: 1828 Webster's dictionary

- 1. an animal with one horn; the monoceros. this name is often applied to the rhinoceros.
- 2. The sea unicorn is a fish of the whale kind, called narwal, remarkable for a horn growing out at his nose.

The word Rhinoceros: 1828 Webster's dictionary

A genus of quadrupeds of two species, one of which, the unicorn, as a single horn growing almost erect from the nose. This animal when full grown, is said to be 12 feet in length. There is another species with two horns, the bicornis. They are natives of Asia and Africa.



Size of the ark: 510 ft L x 85 ft W x 51 ft H. NFL football field is 360 ft (including the end zones) by 160 ft wide = 57,600 sq ft. Each layer or floor of the ark was 43,500 sq ft. X 3 floors totaling 130,000 square feet.

Note: There is an approximate total of 8,000 kinds of animals: land, air and sea. Only the animals breathing air in the nostrils were on the ark.

While there are many land-dwelling, air-breathing animal species, there are only about 1,398 such kinds, including extinct ones. This means Noah only needed to bring around 6,744 animals onto the ark (instructions on some animals were more than 2). While some animals are quite large, many of these are very small, with the average creature being about the size of a sheep. So, there was plenty of room on the ark for a few thousand animals, Noah and his family, and the supplies they would need to survive the year-long voyage.



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
