2 Peter 3:1-7 AMPC

1 Beloved, I am now writing you this second letter. In [both of] them I have stirred up your unsullied (sincere) mind by way of remembrance,

2 That you should recall the predictions of the holy (consecrated, dedicated) prophets and the commandment of the Lord and Savior [given] through your apostles (His special messengers).

3 To begin with, you must know and understand this, that scoffers (mockers) will come in the last days with scoffing, [people who] walk after their own fleshly desires

4 And say, Where is the promise of His coming? For since the forefathers fell asleep, all things have continued exactly as they did from the beginning of creation.

5 For they willfully overlook and forget this [fact], that the heavens [came into] existence long ago by the word of God, and the earth also which was formed out of water and by means of water,

6 Through which the world that then [existed] was deluged with water and perished. 7 But by the same word the present heavens and earth have been stored up (reserved) for fire, being kept until the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly people.

Remember, the Bible is **infallible** (as stated in 2 Peter 1:19). It is truth, it is life and it cleanses our thoughts and separates us from the world/cultures way of thinking to prepare us for a divine purpose. Peter was writing the church in response to the question what must we do to be ready for Jesus return. The Roman government and religious leaders were literally killing people who believed that was Jesus or prophecy being fulfilled.

2 Peter 1:19-21 AMPC

19 And we have the prophetic word [made] firmer still. You will do well to pay close attention to it as to a lamp shining in a dismal (squalid [extremely dirty] and dark) place, until the day breaks through [the gloom] and the Morning Star rises ([a]comes into being) in your hearts.

20 [Yet] first [you must] understand this, that no prophecy of Scripture is [a matter] of any personal or private or special interpretation (loosening, solving).

21 For no prophecy ever originated because some man willed it [to do so—it never came by human impulse], but men spoke from God who were borne along (moved and impelled) by the Holy Spirit.

In part 2 we left off with an example (one of many we will be seeing) of how to manipulate or lie to get the desired outcome in attempting to educate/indoctrinate. Many teacher's (not all) are told to stress certain types of information. This is an excerpt from the Prentice Hall General Science, 1992, page 61.

The Birth and Death of the Universe

How was the universe born and how will it end? Most astronomers believe that about 18 to 20 billion years ago all the matter in the universe was concentrated into one very dense, very hot region that may have been much smaller than a period on this page. For some unknown reason, this region exploded. This explosion is called the big bang.

Notice “most astronomers believe 18-20 billions of years ago” - that’s not measurable, testable or observable. Then, all the matter in the universe was concentrated in an area “smaller than a period of this page” or “I have a theory” or “I think”. As soon as you use the two words “I think” instead of “God says”, you know right away that's not the truth.

18 ... **Tell Me, if you know it all.**

John 14:6 AMPC

6 Jesus said to him, **I am the Way and the Truth and the Life; no one comes to the Father except by (through) Me.**

Let’s look at the question that was asked in this example: **How was the universe born and how will it end?** Interesting, the word universe is broken down into 2 parts: Uni=single and verse =spoken sentence.

Genesis 1 AMPC

1 *In the beginning God (prepared, formed, fashioned, and) created the heavens and the earth.*

3 **And God said, Let there be light; and there was light.**

6 **And God said,** *Let there be a firmament [the expanse of the sky] in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters [below] from the waters [above].*

9 **And God said,** *Let the waters under the heavens be collected into one place [of standing], and let the dry land appear. And it was so.*

11 **And God said,** *Let the earth put forth [tender] vegetation: plants yielding seed and fruit trees yielding fruit whose seed is in itself, each according to its kind, upon the earth. And it was so.*

14 **And God said,** *Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be signs and tokens [of God’s provident care], and [to mark] seasons, days, and years,*

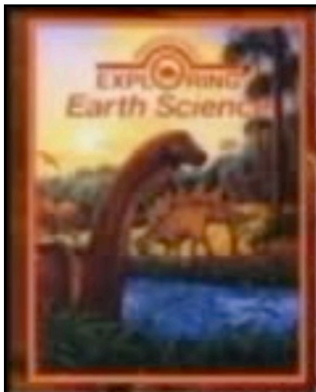
20 **And God said,** *Let the waters bring forth abundantly and swarm with living creatures, and let birds fly over the earth in the open expanse of the heavens.*

24 **And God said,** *Let the earth bring forth living creatures according to their kinds: livestock, creeping things, and [wild] beasts of the earth according to their kinds. And it was so.*

26 **God said,** *Let Us [Father, Son, and Holy Spirit] make mankind in Our image, after Our likeness, and let them have complete authority over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the [tame] beasts, and over all of the earth, and over everything that creeps upon the earth.*

The Universe came into existence by God speaking **one sentence.**

We are going to continue reading from “Science” books - the (updated) Prentice Hall General Science, 1999, page 63... remember everything in the Universe came from inside a small dot, the size of a period on this page. This is their “theory”... or their “science”.



a halt. Then gravity will begin to pull the
back toward the center of the universe.
As happens, every galaxy will begin to show
shift in its spectrum. Recall that a blue shift

22 Claiming to be wise, they became fools [professing to be smart, they made simpletons of themselves].

Read what the conclusions were of this author who wrote this Science Curriculum... HBJ General Science, 1989, Page 362.

If the universe is expanding, then it must have once been much smaller. If you could run the life of the universe in reverse, like a film, you would see the universe contracting until it disappeared in a flash of light, leaving nothing.

In the realm of the universe, nothing really means nothing. Not only matter and energy would disappear, but also space and time. However, physicists theorize that from this state of nothingness the universe began in a gigantic explosion about 16.5 billion years ago. This theory of the origin of the universe is called the Big Bang theory. The Big Bang theory does not exp

In order to ease and persons conscience about judgement, who created the universe, who can destroy the universe, who created mankind and who can judge mankind... humanists or evolutionist have come up with a theory, not science. (Science is measurable, testable and observable) The scientist came up with: Nothing exploded and something was created and this is was it taught in most schools.

Discover magazine April 2002 said, “The Universe burst into something from absolutely nothing - zero, nada. As it got bigger, it became filled with even more stuff that came from absolutely nowhere. How is that possible? Ask Alan Guth. His theory of inflation helps explain everything.”

Alan Guth said in Scientific American, “...the observable Universe could have evolved from an infinitesimal region. It’s then tempting to go one step further and speculate that the entire Universe evolved from literally nothing.” This is from a science journal and is called science...

In all of these Big Bang theories, ultimately, there is some dirt involved but no one can explain where it came from? So nothing, came from nothing or something came from nothing and or dirt evolved after it exploded. This ideology is what Peter called “willfully ignorant” or “dumb on purpose.”

A Creationist believes, in the Beginning God created the earth 6,000 years ago and the Evolutionist or Humanist believes, in the Beginning Dirt 20 billion years ago. These 2 different or opposite beliefs is a choice, which one do you believe?

The religion of evolution and the religion of twisting God’s Word in the church regarding sin, judgment, righteousness and the “things” or judgments to come is all from satan... Jesus said so.

Let’s get back to science, the systemized knowledge derived from observation.

First law of thermodynamics:

Matter and or energy can't be created or destroyed.

Everything is made of matter, so, if matter can't be created or destroyed... how did the world get here? How did we get here?

So, where did matter come from?

Where did the laws come from?

- Law of Gravity**
- Law of Inertia**
- Law of Centrifugal Force**
- Boyle's law**

Why don't laws evolve? Why is gravity always the same? Where does energy come from to heat your house?

There is a law in physics called the conservation of angular momentum. If a spinning object break apart, the pieces that break off will spin in the same direction. The reason, the outside is moving faster then the inside.

Evolutionists believe this law, it is measurable testable and observable... so, why do 2 and possible three of the planets rotate backwards from the other 6 planets. (Venus, Uranus and possibly Pluto - former planet). Did you know that 8 of the 91 moons spin backwards? Jupiter, Saturn and Neptune have moons orbiting in both directions. (Astronomical Almanac Washington DC U.S. Government Printing Office 1989 p. E88)

Why is the sun 98% hydrogen and helium but the other planets are less then 1% hydrogen and helium? Why are all the planets so different from each other if they all came from a Big Bang? Why do some galaxies spin in the opposite direction?

Genesis 1:1 KJV

1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

God changed these “things” up so the Big Bang would make man outside of God's Word look stupid - AND IT DOES, dumb on purpose. Man has taken the measurable, testable and observable “things” or laws of science and drawn the conclusion that doesn't make sense based on their own input. Man does not want to have an outcome where God is going to judge and where God created everything.

If there was a Big Bang and everything we see now is a result of billions of years of evolution, what is the purpose of Jesus coming down to earth and dying on the cross to save us from our sins?

1) Jesus came to fulfill the law.

Matthew 5:17 AMPC

17 Do not think that I have come to do away with or [a]undo the Law or the Prophets; I have come not to do away with or undo but to complete and fulfill them.

2) Jesus came to divide.

Luke 12:51 AMPC

51 Do you suppose that I have come to give peace upon earth? No, I say to you, but rather division;

Matthew 10:34 AMPC

34 Do not think that I have come to bring peace upon the earth; I have not come to bring peace, but a sword.

3) Jesus came to call sinners.

Mark 2:17 AMPC

17 And when Jesus heard it, He said to them, Those who are strong and well have no need of a physician, but those who are weak and sick; I came not to call the righteous ones to repentance, but sinners (the erring ones and all those not free from sin).

Luke 5:32 AMPC

32 I have not come to arouse and invite and call the righteous, but [the erring ones (those not free from sin) to repentance [to change their minds for the better and heartily to amend their ways, with abhorrence of their past sins].

4) Jesus came to serve and give his life.

Mark 10:45 AMPC

45 For even the Son of Man came not to have service rendered to Him, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for (instead of) many.

5) Jesus came to proclaim good news.

Luke 4:18-19 AMPC

18 The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me, because He has anointed Me [the Anointed One, the Messiah] to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth as delivered those who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity],

19 To proclaim the accepted and acceptable year of the Lord [the day when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound].

6) Jesus came to seek and save the lost.

Luke 19:10 AMPC

10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save that which was lost.

Mark 10:45 AMPC

45 For even the Son of Man came not to have service rendered to Him, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for (instead of) many.

7) Jesus came that the world might be saved.

John 3:17 AMPC... (page 10)

John 3:17 AMPC

17 For God did not send the Son into the world in order to judge (to reject, to condemn, to pass sentence on) the world, but that the world might find salvation and be made safe and sound through Him.

8) Jesus came to do his Father's will to keep, save, and resurrect believers.

John 6:38-40 AMPC

38 For I have come down from heaven not to do My own will and purpose but to do the will and purpose of Him Who sent Me.

39 And this is the will of Him Who sent Me, that I should not lose any of all that He has given Me, but that I should give new life and raise [them all] up at the last day.

40 For this is My Father's will and His purpose, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in and cleaves to and trusts in and relies on Him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up [from the dead] at the last day.

9) Jesus came for judgment.

John 9:39 AMPC

39 Then Jesus said, I came into this world for judgment [as a Separator, in order that there may be separation between those who believe on Me and those who reject Me], to make the sightless see and to make those who see become blind.

10) Jesus came to give abundant life.

John 10:10 AMPC

10 The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows).

11) Jesus came so believers may not remain in darkness.

John 12:46 AMPC

46 I have come as a Light into the world, so that whoever believes in Me [whoever cleaves to and trusts in and relies on Me] may not continue to live in darkness.

12) Jesus came to bear witness to the truth.

John 18:37 AMPC

37 Pilate said to Him, Then You are a King? Jesus answered, You say it! [You speak correctly!] For I am a King. [Certainly I am a King!] This is why I was born, and for this I have come into the world, to bear witness to the Truth. Everyone who is of the Truth [who is a friend of the Truth, who belongs to the Truth] hears and listens to My voice.

God's Word says that HE will restore the earth like it used to be... If there was a Big Bang and everything we see now is a result of billions of years of evolution what will He restore it to be like? Nothing?

This is what God's Word says vs. what Man says

The current heavens and earth have long been subject to God's curse because of mankind's sin. *All creation "has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth" (Romans 8:22)* as it awaits the fulfillment of God's plan and *"the children of God to be revealed" (verse 19)*. Heaven and earth will pass away (Mark 13:31), and they will be replaced by the new heavens and the new earth. At that time, the Lord, seated on His throne, says, *"I am making everything new!" (Revelation 21:5)*. In the new creation, sin will be totally eradicated, and *"there shall be no more curse" (Revelation 22:3)*.

The **new heaven and new earth** are also mentioned in Isaiah 65:17, Isaiah 66:22, and 2 Peter 3:13. Peter tells us that the new heaven and new earth will be "where righteousness dwells." Isaiah says that "the former things will not be remembered, nor will they come to mind."

Things will be completely new, and the old order of things, with the accompanying sorrow and tragedy, will be gone. The new earth will be free from sin, evil, sickness, suffering, and death. It will be similar to our current earth, but without the curse of sin. It will be earth as God originally intended it to be. It will be Eden restored.

The creation of the new heavens and new earth brings the promise that God “*will wipe every tear from their eyes*” (*Revelation 21:4*). This event comes after the tribulation, after the Lord’s second coming, after the millennial kingdom, after the final rebellion, after the final judgment of Satan, and after the Great White Throne Judgment. The brief description of the new heavens and new earth is the last glimpse into eternity that the Bible gives.

Second law of thermodynamics:

Everything tends toward disorder

If you leave anything alone it will rot, rust, decay, break down, fall apart and die...nothing gets better by itself. That is what the Bible teaches before man came up with this law.

Hebrews 1:10-11 AMPC

*10 And [further], **You, Lord, did lay the foundation of the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the works of Your hands.***

*11 They will perish, but You remain and continue permanently; **they will all grow old and wear out like a garment.***

Isaiah 51:6 AMPC

*6 Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath; for the heavens shall be dissolved and vanish away like smoke, **and the earth shall wax old like a garment,** and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner [like gnats]. But My salvation shall be forever, and My rightness and justice [and faithfully fulfilled promise] shall not be abolished.*

Psalm 102:26 AMPC

*26 They shall perish, but You shall remain and endure; yes, **all of them shall wear out and become old like a garment.** Like clothing You shall change them, and they shall be changed and pass away.*

In the natural, nothing or no “thing” gets better by itself, every “thing” tends towards chaos. Look at your baby pictures and look at yourself in the mirror today...that is what the second law of thermodynamics is all about, everything is getting worse and that is what scientist believe. Except about the part regarding...

The second law of thermodynamics states: Everything tends toward disorder.... What is actual science says that “Everything is getting worse, it is deteriorating”. Correct information or input but the conclusion is...willfully ignorant or dumb on purpose. Our ancestors were bacteria? Evolution violates the second law because evolution is wrong.

I can show you example after example from science text books showing images of organisms that state “are billions or years old” that are the remains of the early ancestors of modern human beings.

From primates, millions and or billions of years ago evolving into the modern day human being... remember the science world outside of the Truth, God’s Word needs millions and billion of years so it is not measurable, testable or observable. When you hear or read millions or billions of years ago it really means, “long ago and far away” - it is a fairy tale.

What you believe is how you behave. When you are told from kindergarten thru 12th grade you come from an animal, which came from nothing.... Do you think that has any bearing on how someone thinks and ultimately chooses to live?

Proverbs 8:36 AMPC

36 But he who misses me or sins against me wrongs and injures himself; all who hate me love and court death.

Education today teaches that there are no absolutes. But, if you believe that God created everything, that He will judge us according to His Word/Commands it should change how we behave - HIS ABSOLUTE.

Proverbs 14:12-16 AMPC

12 There is a way which seems right to a man and appears straight before him, but at the end of it is the way of death.

13 Even in laughter the heart is sorrowful, and the end of mirth is heaviness and grief.

14 The backslider in heart [from God and from fearing God] shall be filled with [the fruit of] his own ways, and a good man shall be satisfied with [the fruit of] his ways [with the holy thoughts and actions which his heart prompts and in which he delights].

15 The simpleton believes every word he hears, but the prudent man looks and considers well where he is going.

16 A wise man suspects danger and cautiously avoids evil, but the fool bears himself insolently and is [presumptuously] confident.

When there is no rules, order, commands, directions, consequences from a Ruler or King, there will always be chaos, decay, destruction and that will ultimately lead to death.

Judges 17:6 AMPC

6 In those days there was no king in Israel; every man did what was right in his own eyes.

Judges 21:25 AMPC

25 In those days there was no king in Israel; every man did what was right in his own eyes.

This statement “***every man did what was right in his own eyes***” is made three times in these latter chapters. All was well while Joshua and those who assisted him lived; then gradually came disorder. “What is the meaning of this?... There was no king [or counselor] in Israel because in Israel there was no God. The Lord is King.

You cannot have a [true] king if you have no God. There was no rejection of God, no public and blatant atheism; but, there was a deadlier heresy, namely, keeping God as a sign but paying no tribute to Him as a King. Worshiping Him in outward form but knowing not of the subduing and directing power of godliness/holiness. That is to be dreaded more than any intellectual difficulty of a theological kind... Dead consciences, prayerless prayers, arbitrary obedience to God’s Word.

Everyone did what was right in his own eyes equates to saying that a state of anarchy existed in Israel. Israel's wilderness wandering period was an unsettled time when some of the sacrifices and tithes were not being offered. Moses described this time as ***“everyone doing whatever is right in his own eyes” (Deuteronomy 12:8).***

They did what was right in their own eyes is equivalent to today's philosophy that “if it feels right, then do it” or “you be you.” This is what got Israel (God's People) into trouble, leading the nation into the depths of depravity and moral decay. **It is happening today in the christian church just as the the New Testament writers foretold.**

While man, outside of God says there is no absolutes (I am God), God has an absolute right or righteous way spelled out for us in His Word.

Proverbs 14:12 AMPC

12 There is a way which seems right to a man and appears straight before him, but at the end of it is the way of death.

Why do many scientist, teachers and people in general believe in evolution even though it is outside of the natural laws? it doesn't make sense? why are they drawing a different conclusion then what the measurable, testable and observable input is giving them? Because of the false teaching they have sat underneath and do not believe truth anymore. In many cases to get by and navigate in a world filled with chaos, disorder and not willing to be set apart, people give in and become, say and do things that God said do not do.
